1	Step 1: Obtain an EAN Code • Every Barcode needs an EAN-13 code, • Register your company with GS1 and generate an EAN-13 code • GS1 Activate GS1
2	Step 2: Choose a Barcode Generator Once you have your EAN code, you will need create a barcode image. You can generate this online for free. We recommend using: Option A: Seagull Scientific (BarTender) • Open link: Barcode Generator • Click GS1 (by Symbology) •  GS1 (by Symbology) • Click UPC-A, UPC-E, EAN-13 and EAN-8 •  UPC-A, UPC-E, EAN-1 • Click EAN-13 80% then Select •  EAN-13 , 80% • Enter your EAN-13 code and click "NEXT" Option B: TEC-IT • Open link: Free Online Barcode Generator: Create Barcodes for Free! • Select EAN / UPC •  EAN / UPC • Select EAN-13 •  EAN-13 • Enter your 13-digit EAN code and click refresh • Confirm barcode matches EAN-13 code and Download • Save as a PNG file: YOURProductName-Size-Tint
3	Step 3: Insert it on the label GS1 Retail and Non-Retail Barcode Size Guide.pdf (gs1my.org)
